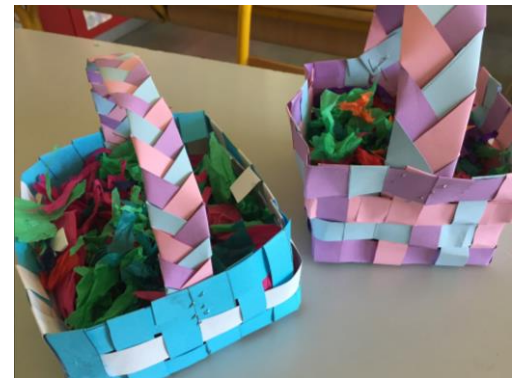
INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY
